Key Words: vocabulary words and expressions related to food and restauration

Supporting Standards—

Brief Summary of Lesson:

Show a map of France with products instead of regions. Explain how the region has used its local products to offer special dishes or "spécialités françaises" comme les " moules marinières".

Show sequences of films showing aspects of table manners and polite expressions in France

Discuss the evolution through time about good manners as a cause of international interaction

Activities:

Distribute menus to students and have them figure out which regions these come from

Use transparency about " les bonnes manières" and make students say which attitude to have in which situations.

Assignment:

Each student will write a text about 2 to 3 paragraphs where he would describe his own cultural habits with reference to " les bonnes manières" in his own culture and have them present to the class a menu from their own country.
