Subject/Course: Spanish

Grade Level: 3<sup>rd</sup> grade

Topic/concept: Ciclo de anidacion de las tortugas.  
(turtles' nesting circle)

Estimated Time Required: 3 ½ weeks (aprox.)

### Desired Results:

1. What do we want students to know or be able to do? List standard(s) and relevant benchmark(s)

#### A) Communication:

- Each of us has the means to take care of beaches, and the animals that live or put their eggs in them, such as turtles
- People' behavior affect flora and fauna (biome)
- Nesting behavior of turtles

Why is it important for turtles that the beach where they lay eggs is clean?

4. In the context of this unit, what specific knowledge or skills do you want the students to acquire?

- How to research about specific topic
- Prepare and perform an oral presentation
- How is the nesting cycle of turtles

- Do an oral presentation about turtles showing their nesting behavior.

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Instructional Plan

Provide a plan of your instructional activities, including time and materials needed. Instructional Activities:

1) Introduction to the unit (three classes):

- Read a story that explain how turtles lay their eggs in the beach
- Orally, answer reading comprehension questions, comments about the topic.
- Look in the dictionary and learn the specific vocabulary in Spanish.

Key words: anidacion, ciclo, nido, reproduccion, proteccion, sobrevivencia, tortugas, cavar, hoyo, arrastrarse, depredador, temperatura, cascaron, huevo, orientacion.

Materials needed: "Bahia de Tortugas", Trofeos, Harcourt, 3<sup>rd</sup> grade. Spanish diccionary.

2) Research about turtles (four classes):

- Investigate on line or in books about specific details in relation with the egg laying cycle of sea turtles.
- Draw a map of the location of different types of sea turtles.
- Write a summary with main information about sea turtles.
- Answer a written questionnaire about sea turtles.

Materials needed: On-line information, sites in Spanish about turtles.

Books about turtles.  
Maps, encyclopedias, etc.  
Written questionnaire about turtles.

3) Prepare Oral Report (two classes):

- Write cards with the info that they present to the class.
- Read and share opinions about a sheet given by the teacher with tips and ways to do a good oral presentation.
- Practice presentation applying tips for a good oral report (Formative Assessment: students and teacher give suggestions to the presenter)

Materials needed: Cards.

Woksheets with tips for a good oral presentation.

4) 3D Model Project (two or three classes):

- Using different materials (cardboard, markers, water pencils, oil paint, playdo, etc.) build a 3D Model of the beach where turtles lay their eggs.

Materials needed: anything needed for a 3D Model of a tropical beach.

5) Present the oral presentation to the class (three classes):

- Using the 3D Model project, say the information they learned about turtles.

Materials Needed: Cards with the info.

3D Model project.

6) Self evaluation of students about their presentations (one class):

- Students use the rubric to self asses their oral reports.

Materials needed: rubric given by the teacher.

7) Poster (three classes):

- Students make a poster in order to create awareness of medio ambiental issues. It could have ideas or instructions for taking care of turtles and their nests.
- Students share their posters with the rest of the class.
- Posters are places inside the classroom or outside (in the corridors, external walls of the Library, etc.)

Material needed: anything useful to create a nice poster about the beach and the turtles.
